Psalm 40:2, 4, 7-8, 8-9, 10


Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will.

 4. I announced your justice in the *vast as - sembly*; I did not restrain my lips, as you, *O LORD, know*."


1. And He put a new song in - *to my mouth*, a hymn *to our God*.

# 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time


Psalm 25:4-5, 6-7, 8-9

2. He tells the number *of the stars*; he calls *each by name.*


3. The LORD sus - *tains the lowly*; the wicked he casts *to the ground.*

## 6th Sunday in Ordinary Time


Psalm 32:1-2, 5, 11

 3. ... ..


