







Gospel Acclamation

Easter Sunday

2nd Sunday of Easter

3rd Sunday of Easter

4th Sunday of Easter

5th Sunday of Easter

I am the way, the truth and the life, says the **Lord**; no one comes to the Father, ex-cept through **me**.

6th Sunday of Easter

Whoever loves me will keep my word, says the **Lord**, and my Father will love him and we will *come to* **him**.

7th Sunday of Easter

I will not leave you orphans, says the **Lord**.
I will come back to you, and
your hearts will re-joice.

Go and teach all nations, says the **Lord**;
I am with you always, until the end of the **world**.


Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of the **faithful** and kindle in them the fire of your **love**.
