


Gospel Acclamation

Verse for Ash Wednesday



Ash Wednesday

If today you *hear his* **voice**, harden *not your* **hearts**.

1st Sunday of Lent

One does not live on *bread a-lone*, but on every word that comes forth from the *mouth of* **God.**

2nd Sunday of Lent

From the shinging cloud the Father's *voice is* **heard:** This is my beloved *Son, hear* **him.**

3rd Sunday of Lent

Lord, you are truly the Savior *of the* **world**; Give me living water, that I may never *thirst a-***gain.**

4th Sunday of Lent

I am the light of the world, *says the* **Lord**; whoever follows me will have the *light of* **life.**

5th Sunday of Lent

I am the resurrection and the life, *says the* **Lord**; whoever believes in me, / even if he dies, will *never* **die**.

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

Christ became obedient to the point of death, / even death *on a* **cross.**

Because of this, God greatly exalted him / and bestowed on him the name which is above *every* **name.**

March 19th - Solemnity of St. Joseph, husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Blessed are those who dwell in your *house, O* **Lord**; they never *cease to* **praise you.**

March 25th - Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord
