






# Gospel Acclamation





### 1st Sunday of Advent

Show us *Lord, your* **love;** and grant us *your sal***-vation**.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Advent

Prepare the way of the Lord, / make *straight his* **paths**: all flesh shall see the salva-tion of **God**.

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Advent

The Spirit of the Lord *is u-pon me*, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings *to the poor*.

### 4th Sunday of Advent

The virgin shall conceive, and *bear a* **son**, and they shall name *him Em-***manuel**.

### <u>Christmas – At the Vigil Mass</u>

Tomorrow the wickedness of the earth will be de-stroyed: the Savior of the world will reign over us.

### **Christmas – Mass During the Night**

I proclaim to you good news of great joy: today a Savior is born for us, / Christ the Lord.

### <u>Christmas – Mass at Dawn</u>

Glory to God *in the* **highest**, and on earth peace to those on whom his *favor* **rests**.

### <u>Christmas – Mass During the Day</u>

A holy day has dawned upon us. / Come, you nations, and a-dore the **Lord**. For today a great light has come u-pon the **earth**.

### Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph

Let the peace of Christ con-trol your hearts; let the word of Christ dwell in you richly.

### Mary, Mother of God – January 1

In the past God spoke to our ancestors *through the* **prophets**; in these last days, he has spoken to us *through the* **Son**.

### **Epiphany of the Lord**

We saw his star at its **rising** and have come to do him **homage**.

### The Baptism of the Lord
