










# Gospel Acclamation for the Advent and Christmas Season







### 1st Sunday of Advent

Show us *Lord, your* **love**; and grant us *your* sal-vation.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Advent

Prepare the way of the Lord, / make *straight his* **paths**: all flesh shall see the salva-*tion of* **God**.

### 3rd Sunday of Advent

The Spirit of the Lord *is u-pon me*, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings *to the poor*.

### 4th Sunday of Advent

Behold, I am the handmaid of the **Lord**.

May it be done to me according to your word.

### <u>Christmas – At the Vigil Mass</u>

Tomorrow the wickedness of the earth will be de-stroyed: the Savior of the world will reign over us.

### **Christmas - Mass During the Night**

I proclaim to you good news of great joy: today a Savior is born for us, / Christ the Lord.

#### <u>Christmas – Mass at Dawn</u>

Glory to God *in the* **highest**, and on earth peace to those on whom his *favor* **rests**.
